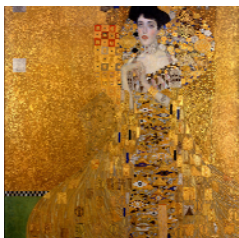


LECTURE: The Golden Age of Art Nouveau

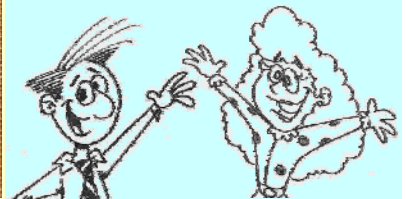
