The Woodbridge Board of Education is presenting a proposal to build a new school, construct necessary upgrades to improve school security and provide critical upgrades to school buildings across the district.

The proposal would generate **NO** tax increase with **NO** cost to residents.

HOW?

The proposal is part of the ongoing joint effort between the Board of Education and the Township government to address the needs of the school system for facility and infrastructure improvements. The project is funded by State Aid and by property taxes generated by a warehouse on the site of the former Woodbridge Developmental Center; not by Township taxpayers.

Total Project Cost: **\$87,718,089**

Project Breakdown:

State Aid: \$18.4 million

Township Economic Redevelopment Projects: \$69.2 million
