This is Woodbridge Mayor John McCormac and today is Friday, May 22.

We've taken our show on the road today. We're at Colonia High School, and in a couple of minutes we're going to bring up all the kids from Colonia Cares who have raised an astounding amount of money for our food pantries, but first, today's announcement.



Woodbridge reported 10 cases of Coronavirus yesterday within the general public with an additional three at our State facilities and one more at St. Joseph's. We have had a long stretch now of numbers now between five and 13 daily so hopefully the days in the 60s, 70s and 80s are gone for good.

Governor Murphy today increased the number of people allowed in an outside gathering from 10 to 25 but the inside gatherings remain limited to 10 people. Whether in or out social distancing must be practiced.

Middlesex County has closed the testing sites at the Motor Vehicle facilities in Edison and South Brunswick. Testing for people who are symptomatic or asymptomatic is now available for County residents at the A.C. Redshaw Elementary School at 216 Livingston Avenue in New Brunswick and as of Thursday another facility will open at 1 Ericsson Drive in Piscataway. Testing is free and by appointment only three days in advance through the County web site at middlesexcountynj.gov and by calling 732 745 3100. All of this information is on our web site.

There are now stories about people pretending to be contact tracers who are calling people, particularly seniors, and asking for personal and financial information under the guise of helping control Covid19. Please do not talk to or give out information to anyone who you do not know personally.

There is an updated listing of virtual and now actual live religious services in Woodbridge Township for this weekend on our Township web site and Facebook pages.

We also continue to post pictures and videos from teachers and parents to our pages and we love doing it so keep sending them in. We also are setting records with people accessing free books and magazines and movies through our Library web site at woodbridgelibrary.org.

Our annual census effort is critically important to Woodbridge as we are very close to the threshold of 100,000 residents which qualifies our Township for increased Federal and State aid so if you have not yet filled out your form please do so and send it in.
