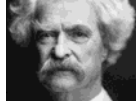
American Political Humor & Satire

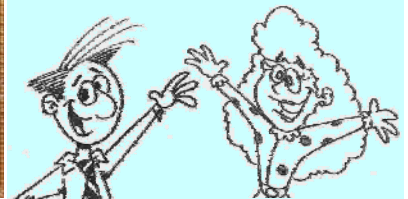
