## APPLICATION / PERMIT FOR CANVASSING TOWNSHIP OF WOODBRIDGE, NEW JERSEY CHAPTER 4, ARTICLE 4-2

Canvassing is defined as the circulation of a petition or, the seeking of contributions for a cause, charitable or otherwise, or the practice of distributing literature, pamphlets, handbills and the like for the purpose of distributing information or seeking support for any legal purpose, from a stationary location on a street or other public place, or by going from house to house, place to place or street to street. House to house canvassing may be conducted between the hours of 9:00 a.m. and 9:00 p.m. Street canvassing is permitted from 9:00 a.m. to sunset. Applications will not be accepted before November 1st of the preceding year the applicant is seeking to canvass. Canvassers must be at least 16 years of age however, if under the age of 18, there must be one adult for every four canvassers. With the exception of non-profit canvassers, three (3) passport size photos plus a valid driver's license of each canvasser (if going from house to house or place to place) must be submitted with this application. Non-profit, religious or political groups canvassing exclusively door-to-door are exempt from this registration requirement.

Street canvassing groups must display at <u>each approach</u> to the stationary location they are canvassing at a sign (minimum 24" x 36"; maximum 36" x 36") indicating the name of the group canvassing. The signs must not present a sight obstruction for motorists.

## POLICY FOR STREET CANVASSER'S

- 1. NO TWO OF THE SAME DAYS WITHIN AN 8-DAY CONSECUTIVE PERIOD WILL BE APPROVED. (i.e., NO TWO SATURDAYS IN A ROW.)
- 2. ONLY 10 OCCURRENCES PER YEAR WILL BE PERMITTED PER ORGANIZATION. (EACH LOCATION IS CONSIDERED AN OCCURRENCE.)
