Annually, Woodbridge Division on Aging reaches out to the community for donations of NEW FANS to assist LOW INCOME residents who have No Cooling Device, cannot afford a cooling device or cannot go to a designated cooling center. Residents who are physically incapacitated; particularly with a respiratory problem, are given priority consideration. The program is not limited to Elderly or Disabled Residents. Low income families that meet eligibility requirements, will also be considered. See eligibility listed below.

TO RECEIVE A FAN - ELIGIBILITY

- **Must Be Woodbridge Resident**
- **Have No Cooling Device, or Able to Go to a Cool Place.**
- **Residents With Medical/Respiratory Problems, Priority Consideration.**
- **Must Show Proof Of Residence**
- **Fans Are Available Until Donations Run Out.**

PLEASE NOTE !

- **Residents In Apartment Complexes With A Community Air Cooled Area Will Only Be Considered If They Do Not Have Cooling (AC or Fan) and Cannot Leave Apartment Due To A Disability.**

ANNUAL INCOME ELIGIBILITY

- **1 Person \$18, 000.00**
- **2 Persons \$24,000.00**
- **More Than Two Persons: Will Be Determined According To Need.**

TO DONATE A FAN:

We Accept ALL Types - Window, Box, Stand & Table Rotating. Fans MUST Be New-In Box (To Avoid Electrical Problems). We Will Accept Fan Donations All Year Long.
