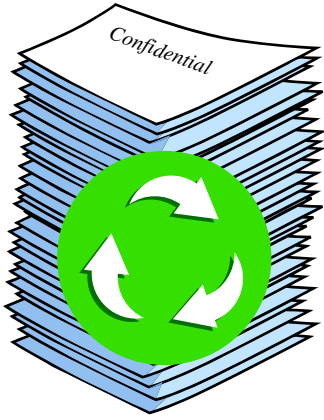
Recycle Paper Documents & Files Safely & Securely

No need to remove paper clips, staples, or paperboard binder covers... it can all be "shredded" and recycled!!!
