Calling All Woodbridge Dogs & Cats Health Department Sponsors FREE Rabies Clinic May 17 & 19 at Health Center

WHAT: The Woodbridge Department of Health & Human Services and Animal Control Division is offering FREE rabies inoculations for Woodbridge Township dogs and cats at the Animal Control Rabies Clinic scheduled for **May 17 and 19, 2010** from **6:00 to 8:00 P.M.** at the Woodbridge Health Center, 2 George Frederick Plaza (adjacent to the Main Library and Woodbridge High School).

All Woodbridge Township pet owners must license and inoculate dogs and cats five months old or older. If a dog or cat has not been inoculated since 2008/2009, the pet must be re-inoculated now. Pet license, proof of prior rabies inoculation, and spaying/neutering certificate must be presented at time of inoculation (except for first-time pet inoculations).

Additionally, Woodbridge Township pet licenses may be purchased at the Rabies Clinic for unlicensed pets. Dog license fees are \$17.00 (non-spayed/neutered) or \$14.00 (spayed/neutered.) Cat license fees are \$22.00 (non-spayed/neutered) and \$12.00 (spayed/neutered). Adults must accompany the pet. Dogs must be leashed and cats must be contained in a closed carrier.
