*The Woodbridge Township United Spinal Rangers Youth Hockey Team includes 10- to 18-year old players who are physically disabled. Sled hockey competition was first developed in Norway for physically- and developmentally challenged youth, and has spread across the globe allowing challenged youngsters to participate in ice hockey – the most popular winter sport. Athletes sit on sleds made of tubular framing supported by metal skate blades. The sled is propelled by picks that are also used to shoot and pass the puck. The United Spinal Rangers are sponsored by the New York Rangers and the United Spinal Association.*
