Woodbridge – Woodbridge Township Mayor John E. McCormac invites Township residents to the first annual Woodbridge Township Animal Shelter & Pet Adoption Center "Open House" on Sat. and Sun., April 26 and 27. The Woodbridge Township Animal Shelter & Pet Adoption Center is the newest, most modern animal shelter in the state, with more than 17 individual dog kennels with extended indoor/outdoor runs; an over-size cattery with individual cages for each feline; separate, fully-ventilated dog and cat quarantine areas; a private animal receiving area and cleaning facility; a "prep" room where incoming animals are examined prior to housing; a private veterinary care clinic where animals are examined and treated; and a laundry for cleaning blankets and kennel wraps. A unique and special feature of the shelter is a public "living-room" area where families can greet and interact with pets prior to adoption. Animal Control officers and shelter volunteers will be on-hand throughout the weekend to assist residents seeking that "purrfect"

pet... and, the Woodbridge Animal Group (a 501C-3 charitable organization) will pay all adoption fees and veterinary costs for every adopted pet.
