Woodbridge Township Veteran's Day Parade & Commemoration set for Sun., Nov. 11

Mayor McCormac Encourages Township to Honor Military Veterans Who Have Served in the Name of Freedom

Woodbridge Twsp. – Public ceremonies commemorating Veteran's Day get underway on **Sun., Nov. 11 at 2:00 p.m.** as Woodbridge Township veterans, military personnel, and marching bands parade down Main Street in honor of those men and women who have served our nation in time of war and in peace. Following the parade, the 16th Annual Veteran's Day Commemoration and Service will be held at the historic First Presbyterian Church at 7:00 p.m.

"This year marks the first time that Township veterans and military personnel will march to Town Hall where they will be honored for their service to our Township, state and nation," Mayor McCormac said. "It is a great privilege to recognize our veterans and to let them know that we appreciate their sacrifice in the defense of our freedom and for their service to our nation in times of emergency and disaster."

The Woodbridge Township Veteran's Day parade steps-off from St. James Church on Main Street at 2:30 p.m. and concludes at the reviewing stand in front of Town Hall. Join Township veterans organizations and military personnel (American Legion Post #87, American Legion Post #471, the Avenel Detachment, U.S. Marine Corps League, Hopelawn Memorial Post #1352 V.F.W., Colonia Memorial Post #6061 V.F.W., Avenel Memorial Post #7164 V.F.W.), representatives from various scouting, youth, civic and historic organizations, the Woodbridge High School marching band, the Black Hawk Drum & Bugle Corps, and the Parade Grand Marshall in honor of Veteran's Day 2007.

The Veteran's of Woodbridge Township will present their 16th Annual Veteran's Day Commemoration on Sun., Nov. 11 at 7:00 p.m. in the sanctuary of the historic First Presbyterian Church, 600 Rahway Avenue, Woodbridge. The processional lineup begins at 6:30 p.m. The program honors all American veterans, living and deceased, who served in war or peacetime and those men and women currently serving in the military.
