- ▶ **Mayor's Striped Bass Tournament Set for Oct. 27 in Sewaren**
- ▶ **Cash prizes offered; proceeds to benefit ill Township child**

WOODBIDGE – Woodbridge Township will host the first annual **Mayor's Striped Bass Tournament** on Oct. 27 from 6 a.m.-5 p.m., Mayor John E. McCormac has announced.

The tournament sails off from the Sewaren Boat Launch, with anglers vying for the biggest striped bass and prizes of \$1,000 for 1<sup>st</sup> place, \$500 for 2<sup>nd</sup> place, \$250 for 3<sup>rd</sup> place, \$150 for 4<sup>th</sup> place and \$100 for 5<sup>th</sup> place (based on participation of 40 boats).

The largest striped bass ever caught by an individual fisherman was a 78.5 lb. specimen taken off Atlantic City in 1982.

“This is a great recreation event that showcases our restored Sewaren waterfront, but we also have a serious purpose,” says **Mayor McCormac**. “The tournament proceeds will be used to help with medical bills incurred by the family of a critically ill Township child.”
