**WOODBIDGE** – Mayor John E. McCormac today announced that the Woodbridge Department of Health & Human Services will continue to administer flu and pneumonia vaccine to Township residents at a Flu Shot Clinic set for **Mon., Nov. 5 from 9:30 to 11:30 a.m.** at the Woodbridge Township Health Center located at 2 George Frederick Plaza in Woodbridge. Flu shots are free to Medicare patients (must present a valid Medicare card) and \$15.00 for all other patients. Woodbridge Township residents are encouraged to call the Health Center's Nursing Division at (732) 855-0600 x5011 to schedule an appointment.

Township Health Director Dennis Green said that adults over age 50, health care providers, caretakers for high risk patients, residents of nursing homes and other institutions housing long-term care patients, women who will be in the second or third trimester of pregnancy during flu season and individuals with chronic heart and lung problems, diabetes and conditions that lower body resistance should receive annual flu shots. Healthy adults 65 years of age and older and adults of any age with chronic heart and lung disease or serious chronic disease that may affect the lungs should receive a one-timer dose pneumonia vaccine.

“Flu shots are the first line of defense against a very serious illness,” Mayor McCormac said. “This year, we have plenty of flu vaccine and are endeavoring to make it as easy as possible for Township residents to get a flu shot by offering convenient clinics at the Health Center. If you haven't gotten your flu shot yet... contact the Health Department at 732-855-0600 x5011 and schedule your appointment today.”
