WOODBIDGE – Woodbridge Township Mayor John E. McCormac believes the Oct. 11 **Barron Arts Fine Art Festival** is a great way to showcase the diversity of fine arts in Woodbridge.

Music will be provided by the **Joe Frame Trio**, a renowned Woodbridge-based chamber jazz and Brazilian music ensemble.
