Calling All Woodbridge Dogs & Cats

Health Department Sponsors FREE Rabies Clinic Sept. 15, 17 and 18, 2008 @ Health Center

WHAT: The Woodbridge Department of Health & Human Services and Animal Control is offering ***FREE*** rabies inoculations for Woodbridge Township dogs and cats at the bi-annual Animal Control Rabies Clinic scheduled for Sept. 15, 17 and 18, 2008 from 6:30 to 8:00 p.m. at the Woodbridge Health Center, 2 George Frederick Plaza (adjacent to the Main Library and Woodbridge High School).

All Woodbridge Township pet owners must license and inoculate dogs and cats five months old or older. If a dog or cat has not been inoculated since 2006/2007, the pet must be re-inoculated now. Pet license, proof of prior year rabies inoculation and spaying/neutering certificate must be presented at time of inoculation (except for first-time pet inoculations).

Additionally, Woodbridge Township pet licenses may be purchased at the Rabies Clinic for unlicensed pets. Dog license fees are \$17.00 (non-spayed/neutered) or \$14.00 (spayed/neutered)... cat license fees are \$22.00 (non-spayed/neutered) and \$12.00 (spayed/neutered). Adults must accompany the pet... dogs must be leashed and cats must be contained in a closed carrier.
