- ▶ **Woodbridge Animal Shelter Sponsors Open House Oct. 4**
- ▶ **Pet adoption fees waived for the day at state-of-the-art shelter**

WOODBIDGE – Woodbridge Township Mayor John E. McCormac invites Township residents to an “Open House” at Woodbridge Township Animal Shelter & Pet Adoption Center on Sat., Oct. 4 from 10 a.m.-2 p.m.

The shelter is located at 195 Woodbridge Avenue in Sewaren. All adoption fees will be waived for the day and paid for by the Woodbridge Animal Group.

The Woodbridge Township Animal Shelter & Pet Adoption Center opened December, 2007, and is the newest, most modern animal shelter in the state.

Shelter features include 17 individual dog kennels; a large-size cattery with individual cages for each feline; separate, fully-ventilated dog and cat quarantine areas; a private animal receiving area and cleaning facility; a “prep” room where incoming animals are examined prior to housing; a private veterinary care clinic where animals are examined and treated; a laundry for cleaning blankets and kennel wraps; a public “living-room” area where families can greet and interact with pets prior to adoption.
