The Port Reading fire Department and First Aid Squad have their annual tree lighting at 7:15 Tuesday night at the firehouse.

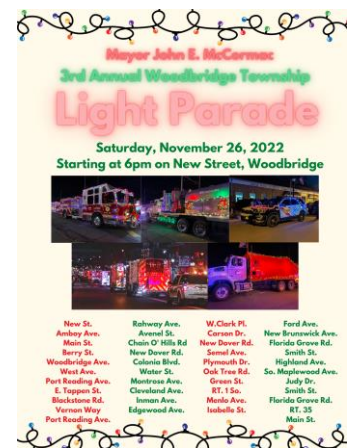
