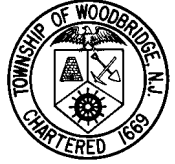

The nationally-sponsored award sets standards for community sustainability, rating municipal communities on more than 526 different indicators for their economic, environmental, and sustainable achievements.

“Greenable & Sustainable Woodbridge” is a long-term, Township-wide environmental awareness initiative geared to provide information to residents, businesses and visitors about real, environmentally-friendly sustainable programs and alternatives. “Greenable Woodbridge” identifies the environmental and sustainable issues of importance to the future of the community and provides the direction and initiatives to establish Woodbridge Township as a leader in sustainable living.
