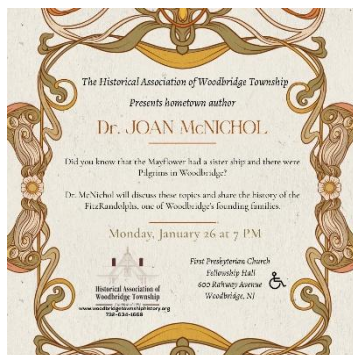


MAYOR JOHN E. McCORMAC

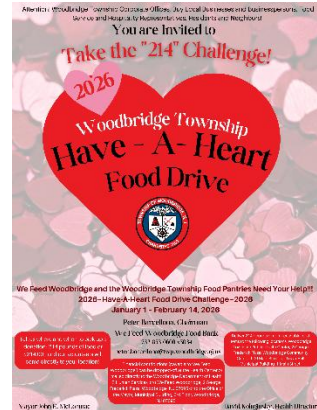
Our "Have-A-Heart" food drive is in full swing so food can be brought to the Health Center, Town Hall or
