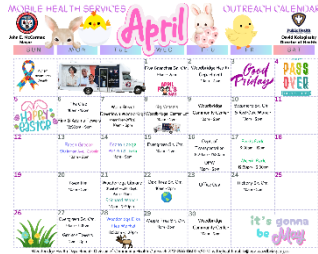
The Writers Group is meeting at the Main Library at 6:30 pm on Tuesday.

The Colonia Library has the Crochet Club Thursday at 6:00 pm.



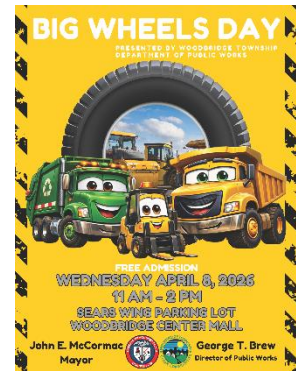
